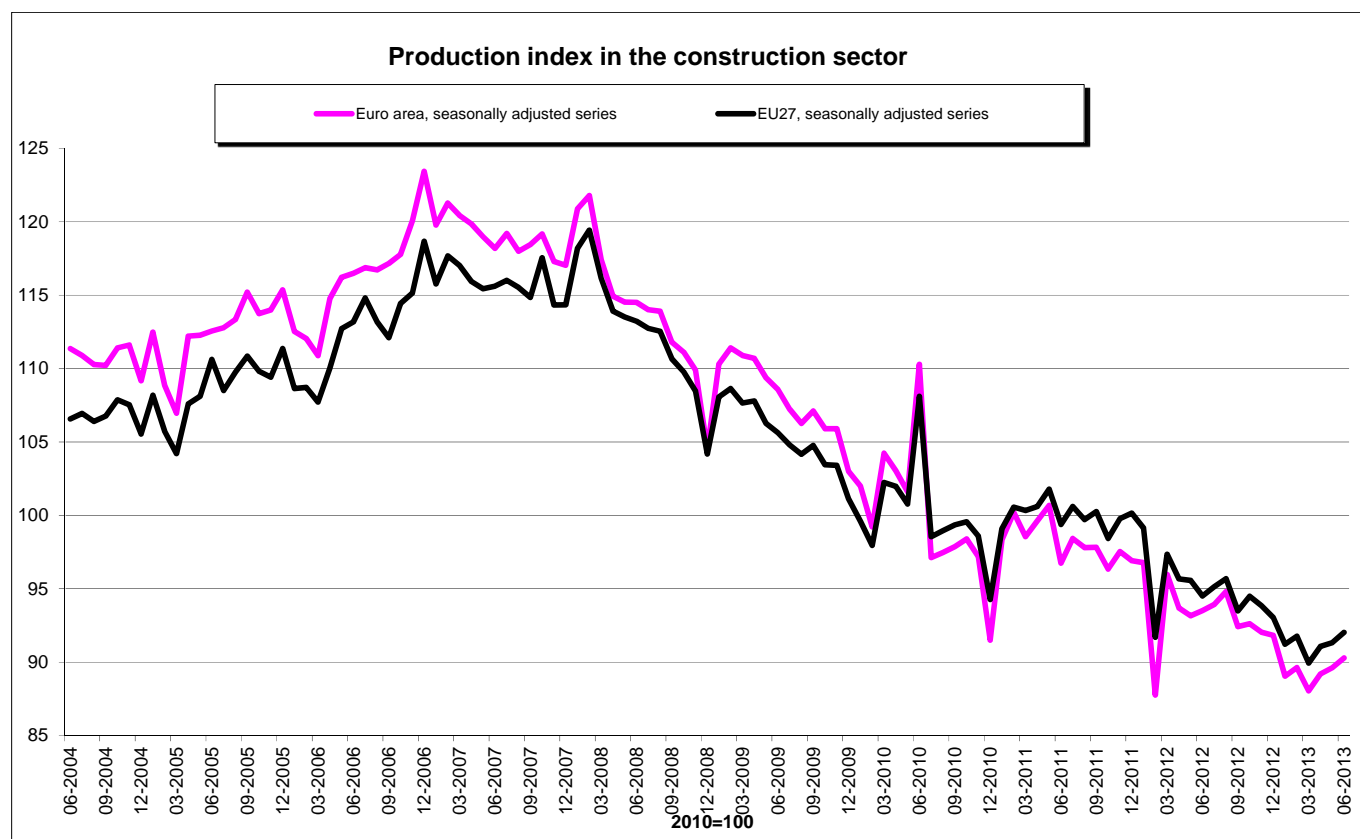
June 2013 compared with May 2013

## Euro area production in construction up by 0.7%

Up by 0.8% in EU27

In the construction sector, seasonally adjusted production<sup>1</sup> rose by 0.7% in the **euro area**<sup>2</sup> (EA17) and by 0.8% in the **EU27**<sup>2</sup> in June 2013, compared with the previous month, according to first estimates released by **Eurostat, the statistical office of the European Union**. In May 2013<sup>3</sup>, production rose by 0.5% and 0.3% respectively.

Compared with June 2012, production decreased by 3.0% in the **euro area** and by 1.5% in the **EU27** in June 2013.



## Monthly comparison

Among the Member States for which data are available for June 2013, production in construction rose in four, fell in six and remained stable in **Spain, France and Hungary**. The increases were registered in **Slovenia (+10.5%), Poland (+5.3%), Germany (+1.6%)** and the **Czech Republic (+1.3%)**, and the largest decreases in **Romania (-2.4%), Portugal (-2.2%)** and **Sweden (-0.9%)**.

Building construction grew by 0.3% in the **euro area** and by 0.5% in the **EU27**, after +0.2% and 0.0% respectively in May 2013. Civil engineering rose by 1.3% in the **euro area** and by 1.5% in the **EU27**, after +0.6% and +0.7% respectively in the previous month.

## Annual comparison

Among the Member States for which data are available for June 2013, production in construction fell in ten and rose in three. The largest decreases were registered in **Poland (-16.3%), Portugal (-12.0%), Slovakia (-10.7%)** and the **Czech Republic (-9.8%)**, and the increases in **Hungary (+12.5%), Spain (+4.1%)** and **Sweden (+3.1%)**.

Building construction decreased by 3.1% in the **euro area** and by 1.2% in the **EU27**, after -3.7% and -3.6% respectively in May 2013. Civil engineering fell by 3.0% in the **euro area** and by 2.5% in the **EU27**, after -4.9% and -6.7% respectively in the previous month.

1. The index of production in construction approximates the evolution of the volume of production within the sector, broken down into building construction and civil engineering. For the Member States which produce the construction index, but do not provide data for the reference period, Eurostat estimates missing values in order to calculate euro area and EU aggregates.

Seasonally adjusted euro area and EU series are calculated by aggregating the seasonally adjusted national data. Eurostat carries out the seasonal adjustment of the data for those countries that do not adjust their data for seasonal effects. The monthly index as presented in this News Release is calculated only on the basis of the data of those countries reporting monthly data.

2. The euro area (EA17) includes Belgium, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Italy, Cyprus, Luxembourg, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Portugal, Slovenia, Slovakia and Finland.

Up to 30 June 2013, the European Union (EU27) included Belgium (BE), Bulgaria (BG), the Czech Republic (CZ), Denmark (DK), Germany (DE), Estonia (EE), Ireland (IE), Greece (EL), Spain (ES), France (FR), Italy (IT), Cyprus (CY), Latvia (LV), Lithuania (LT), Luxembourg (LU), Hungary (HU), Malta (MT), the Netherlands (NL), Austria (AT), Poland (PL), Portugal (PT), Romania (RO), Slovenia (SI), Slovakia (SK), Finland (FI), Sweden (SE) and the United Kingdom (UK). From 1 July 2013 the European Union (EU28) also includes Croatia (HR).

As part of Eurostat's guidelines for the dissemination of data when the EU is enlarged, the aggregate data series commented on in this News Release refer to the official composition of the EU in the most recent month for which data is available. Thus News Releases with data for months up to June 2013 will comment on EU27 series, while Releases with data for July 2013 onwards will comment on EU28 series.

3. Data of previous months have been revised compared with those issued in News Release 111/2013 of 17 July 2013. The monthly growth rates for May 2013 have been revised from -0.3% to +0.5% for the euro area and from -0.2% to +0.3% for the EU27. The annual growth rates have been revised from -5.1% to -3.8% for the euro area and from -5.1% to -4.3% for the EU27.
4. Due to the change of base year, data for Belgium are confidential until publication by the National Statistical Institute.
