Population by Age and Sex as of January 1, (2012-2013)

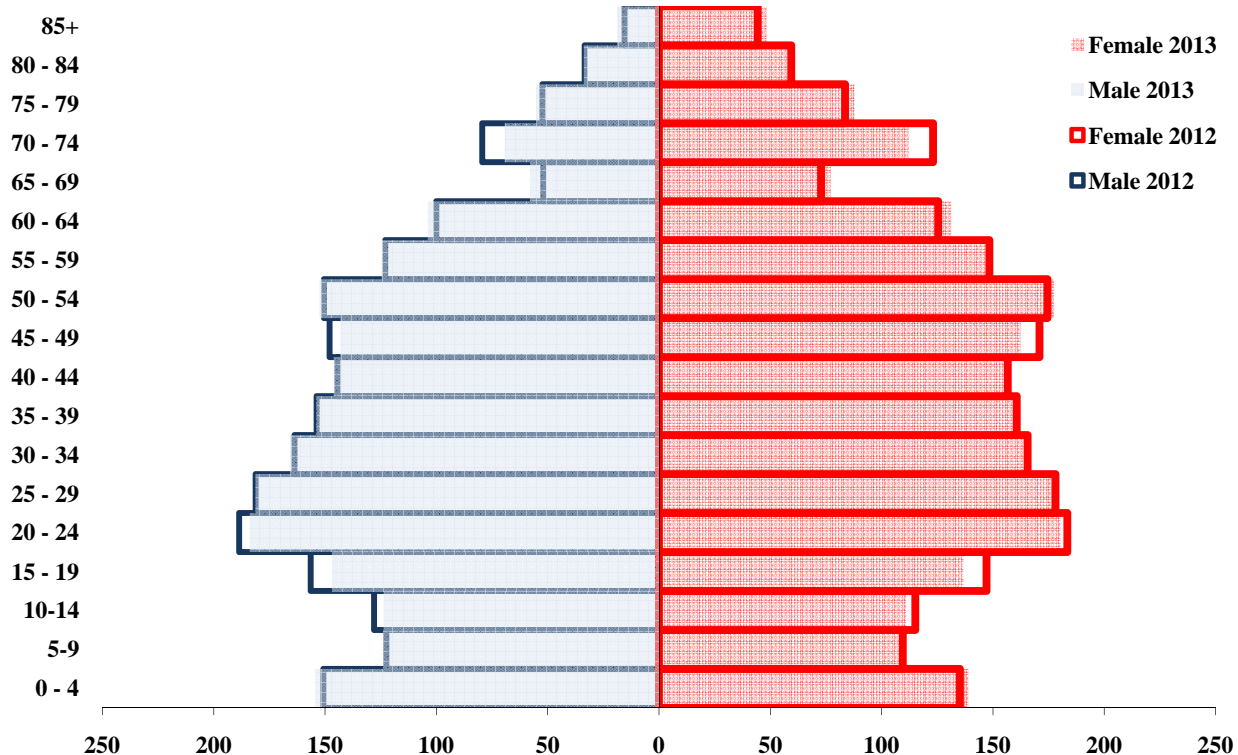

Emigrants and Immigrants by Age and Sex, 2012

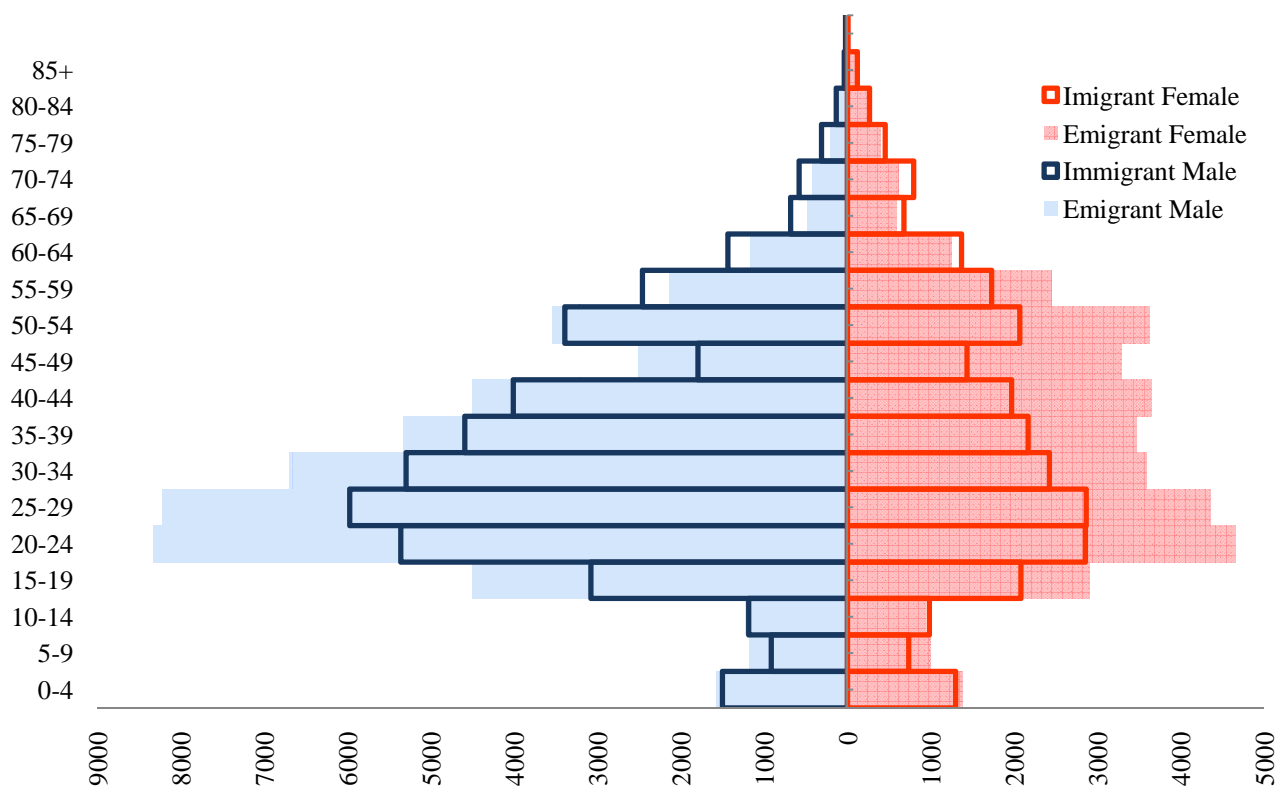

Emigrants and Immigrants by Citizenship, 2012

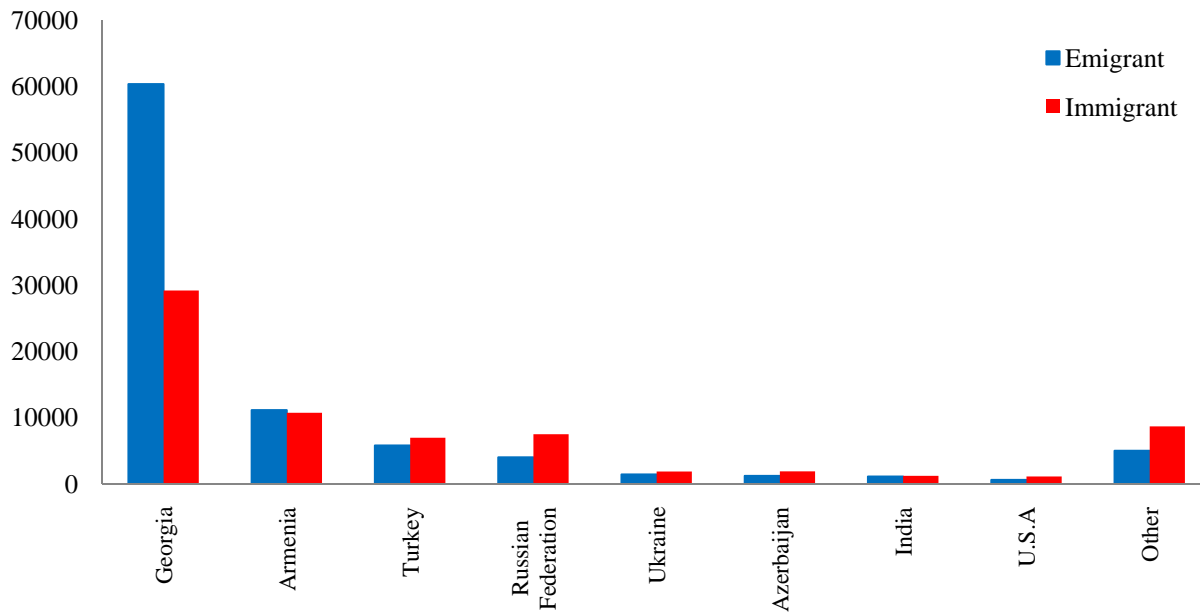
